Village Banners- Kelly Recktenwald

- The Town of Canandaigua has banners in their downtown and lake area. These banners reflect positive attributes like wellness, diversity, respectful, communicator, and responsible. The banners are of young children's art.
- Kelly contacted Honeoye Falls and asked if there would be interest in doing this here. The cost would be about \$130 per banner. Cindy and Jen suggested that we look into a grant. This might be an after school program or art club. K-12 art teachers are interested. We might be able to use the Assets Program for key words. We will continue to pursue this as a project of interest.

Facilitating Art Clubs- Lisa

There are some things we can do to begin our path for independently facilitating K-12 art clubs.

- Identify a parent volunteer willing to handle the finances.
- Talk to Nancy Middleton with Music Boosters and/or Kim Brienzi for band camp. They can share their process.
- Create a process. (No art teachers handle money. All enrollment costs go to art boosters. Art boosters pay the teacher of the class.
- Decide on a cost for the class. Do we maintain the current cost?
- Tris is willing to manage the financial aspects.
- Tris will contact Nancy Middleton. Cindy will contact Kim Brienzi.
- We will attempt to get this up and running for January.
- Can the classes or clubs be with adults, too?

- We received a thank you note from Stan Munro a visiting artist to the High School. He displayed Toothpick City II a project he is currently creating. The media came in and shot footage that will be aired locally. Art Boosters paid a \$100 stipend to facilitate his visit.

Kiln Update

- The kiln is on the high school property. The unit ordered is not the proper wattage. It needs to be rewired at a cost of \$430. David Roth, the high school principal, is looking at a budget line to pay for the rewiring. The work will be done in the next 5 days. Unfortunately, the room is not ready to house the kiln yet. Venting is the next hurdle to get over.
- Next year the HS will be adding Sculpture 2, Printmaking, and photography as dual credit course with MCC. We are looking forward to a jewelry course in the near future.

Treasurer's Report

- Our current balance is 4,111. 73. There are no current debts.

Capital Project Meeting

- Cindy and Tris went to the recent meeting. There are options for each building that are being offered for input. The plan for MS that Tris and Cindy liked best has the art room relocated. There would be two art rooms together. The high school did not have major impact with updates but an enlarged art suite of classrooms is in one plan.
- We would like to get a chance to look at the plans and have time to process the possibilities.

Manor Grant

- Cindy Zauski is looking forward to working with a visiting artist to create a mural inside the school. Cindy will meet with Carol Rinere to get information on what kinds of materials can be used for the indoor mural. The theme will be Earth Day based with hooks, shelves or Velcro for changing displays. The constraint of what materials we can use is currently the focus. Carol will help with that. There are many steps along the way to get this off the ground. Art Boosters may be tapped to cover costs of materials.
