Banner Project: High School Art teacher, Kelly Recktenwald, presented an idea for students to create asset themed banners to hang and display at each of the school buildings. The asset committee will support this project and will provide partial funding and assist with grant opportunities.

Youth Risk Behavior Survey: The survey will be completed again this year. This year, it will be done through Survey Monkey for the first time to reduce costs associated with paper and copying and to obtain results quickly.

Email List: The Assets email list has been expanded to include Key Communicators and other key community members.

Youth Day of Caring – May 8 is the annual Day of Caring. The Assets Committee will begin planning a project for this year. Suggestions and ideas are welcomed.

Student Community Projects: The Middle School held a food drive, organized by the Student Council, to benefit the Honeoye Falls and Lima food pantries. 1500 food items were donated by Middle School, exceeding their goal of 1000. Students received a dollar off admission for their December dance if they donated a food item. 1200 food items went to the Lima food pantry and 300 went to the Honeoye Falls food pantry. The High School won the 98 PXY Penny Drive, donating more money to Hillside than any other school. Almost \$4000 was raised in one week. The senior class raised the most money and won a pizza party. As the winner, the High School has won a free concert from Donnie Klang, from MTV's *Making the Band* (date TBD).
