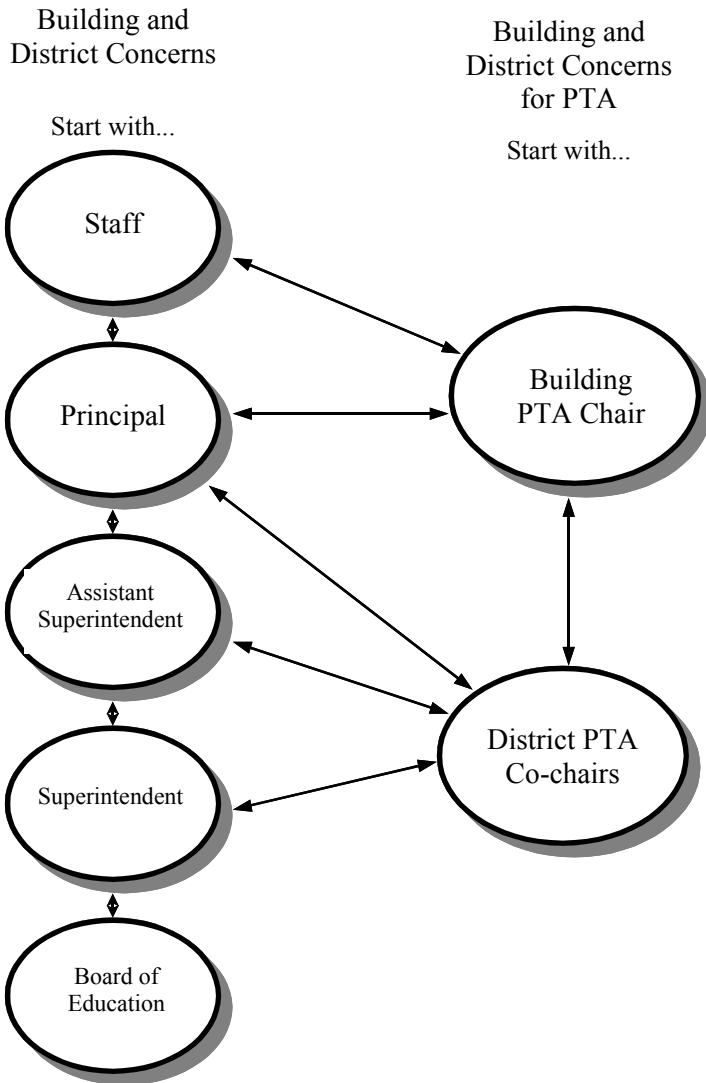


PROTOCOL FOR PROBLEM SOLVING

Good communication between home and school provides a basis of understanding and support that will unite our efforts to help each child's growth and development. School personnel communicate with parents through a variety of methods, including report cards, phone calls, written notes, parent-teacher meetings and open houses. When parents need to contact the school, they should call the individual most closely associated with the area of concern. Please do not expect to reach the individual immediately when you call. Leave your name and telephone number and your call will be returned as soon as possible. Involving your child's teacher and building administrator helps to solve problems in the most efficient and effective way.
