



**Q. How do I know if I need to request additional ballots for my home?**

Qualified voters will receive a ballot automatically at their home address if they are listed on one of the District's tri-county (Monroe, Livingston, Ontario) registered voter lists. Additionally, if a non-registered voter, voted in the HF-L school elections last year, they too will receive a ballot automatically. Finally, any HF-L student who has reached the age of 18 prior to June 9, 2020 and resides in the district, will also automatically receive a ballot.

\*Therefore, only qualified residents who are not on any of the lists mentioned above, will need to request a ballot directly.

**Q. What is the process for voting and returning school budget and board election ballots to the school district?**

Qualified voters who have either automatically received a ballot or requested one, should return their completed ballots in the envelopes provided by the District. Residents will cast their votes by darkening the bubble which corresponds to their selections on the ballot. The official absentee ballot envelope authenticates each ballot when the qualified voter signs the back of the envelope and seals it. A self-addressed, postage-paid envelope will be provided to each voter to return the official signed absentee ballot, with the completed ballot inside. Simply place the postage-paid, sealed envelope(s) in the outgoing mail. Ballots may also be dropped off at the District Office at 20 Church Street, Honeoye Falls, NY. All ballots must be received by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 9, 2020.

**Definition of Qualified Voter:** A person shall be entitled to vote in the School District's 2020 Annual Meeting and Election, who is:

1. A citizen of the United States;
2. Eighteen years of age;
3. A resident within the School District for a period of thirty days next preceding June 9, 2020; and
4. No person shall have the right to register for or vote who would not be qualified to register for or vote at an election in accordance with the provisions of section 5106 of the Election Law.
