Goals:

1. Provide students with continuity of instruction that is accessible and clearly communicated to the community.
2. Monitor and maintain student and family connections with their school communities.

Delivery:

1. Students in grades 1-5 will have laptops/iPads available as of Monday, March 23, based on information completed in the Parent Survey. Information on distribution of devices will be available on the website on Friday, March 20.
2. The district has a link on the website to ClassLink, which includes all links to major software programs.
3. On the district website (hflcsd.org), directions for many technology issues are located on the Student Resources tab.
4. Grades 1 and 2 will be directed to existing SeeSaw platform for support moderated by teachers.
5. Zoom web-based video conferencing is available for all teachers and staff.
 - a. Zoom directions are located on the Student Resources section of the HFLCSD webpage.
6. Students in kindergarten will have online or print out assignments and/or supplemental online resources sent home. The focus during this time is for reading and math. Suggestions and ideas for parents and care providers will be sent home via email and/or SeeSaw.
7. In compliance with NYS guidelines, students' IEPs and 504 plans will be implemented to the greatest extent possible.
